

The Motorsports and Countryman's Day

9:30AM Guests arrive and are welcomed with tea, coffee and hot bacon rolls.

10:00AM Guests are briefed on the day's activities by a Director of A Day in the Country. Guests are then divided into five groups, each group will spend fifty minutes at each activity and then move onto the next. The activities will include:

- > **Rage Buggies** – the latest type of grass go-cart. Developed from racing models for the corporate market. Very fast and great fun.
- > **4 x 4 Land Rover Driving** on our 'Jungle Track' in the woods.
- > **Clay Pigeon Shooting** – the original country pursuit with different stands. Light-weight guns are provided for those who prefer to use them.
- > **Fly Fishing for Trout** – at one of three beautiful trout lakes. Any trout caught will be prepared for the guests to take home in an oven ready condition.
- > **Pistol Shooting** at our target range in the woods.

All instruction and equipment will be provided. No previous experience is necessary at any of the activities, as our instructors are very experienced with complete novices.
