1:30pm Guests are briefed on the afternoons activities. Guests are then split into three groups to take part in three activities, guests will spend an hour at each activity and then move onto the next.

- **Segway Vehicles**

Experience the unique feeling of riding one of our Segways. Segways are upright two wheel vehicles that guests stand on and using weight distribution only for speed and direction. Segways are great fun and to drive and can operate on a variety of terrains. Hills, grass, inclines and dirt pose no obstacle to its ability to go where you want to go. Guests will be paired up to ride these segways through an obstacle course and then on our off road track in the woods.

- **Clay Pigeon Shooting**

Shooting at different stands next to the lakes. Light weight guns are provided for those that prefer to use them and our excellent instructors will make everyone a crack shot!

- **Rage Buggies**

These are large grass go-carts At the heart of which is a robust Honda V-Twin engine, giving strong performance from its 620cc capacity. Guests do timed laps around our obstacle course and the team with the best time wins!

4:30pm Guests return to the barn for tea, home-made cakes followed by prize giving for the best at each activity.
